

HOW TO GET A LIBRARY CARD

Addison offers a commitment to service by providing easy access to the Dallas Public Library free of charge.

How to get a Library Card:

- 1. Visit the Addison Athletic Club.
- 2. Provide proof of residency to front desk staff (driver's license, rental agreement, utility bill, etc.).
- 3. Fill out library card form.
- Staff will give you a voucher that you can redeem for a card at Fretz Park Library (Hillcrest Road and Belt Line).



Please Note:

- Only one card per household will be issued.
- Library card membership is renewed on a yearly basis.
- You will have to go to Fretz Park Library to redeem your voucher for a library card and to renew it each year before being able to use it at any other library in the Dallas Library system.

There are several Dallas Public Library branches close to Addison. Call the Dallas Public Library main number 214-670-1700 or visit their website for a complete list of branches and hours. Make sure to check out the library's TexShare program that allows you to use other local libraries in Farmers Branch and Carrollton.

ADDISON ATHLETIC CLUB

In order to obtain a membership, each individual 18 years and older is required to present the following items:

- 1. Your valid driver's license or Texas identification card with your current Addison address.
- 2. A current bill (dated within the past 30 days) with your name and Addison address on it. Examples:

Vehicle Insurance Pay Stub Electric Bill Toll Tag Statement

Bank Statement Cable Bill Vehicle Registration

W-2 Tax Forms Gun Permit Telephone Bill

Bills must already be printed or ready to email to the associate at the time of registration. The email must be the original copy, readable, and must also include the required information listed above.

3. Apartment residents only: Apartment residents must provide an additional signed Verification Form from your apartment leasing office with your name. (Form must be dated within the past 30 days).

Membership fee: A one-time \$10.00 non-refundable fee for processing the application. Memberships expire annually. There is no fee for renewal, but we will need all three current documents listed above for membership renewal. Renewals are done to ensure we have up-to-date information and are serving only Addison residents.

TRASH AND RECYCLING

Trash and Recycling (Single Family Residences)



Collection Days

Monday (for trash and recycling) Thursday (trash only) Collection begins at 7am



Time: Please do not put trash or recycling items out any sooner than 6pm the night before collection day. Per Town Ordinance, all receptacles must be removed from the curb within 12 hours of pick up on Monday and Thursday.

What: You should place garbage in one-way receptacles (i.e. garbage bags) of sufficient strength to hold 35 pounds. Please put garbage bags 3 feet away from your recycling cart. For recycling, residents have the option of an 18-gallon bin or a 64-gallon cart for their residence.

Please do not bag your recycling or put plastic bags in your recycling bin.

Who: Addison contracts with CWD for garbage and recycling. Service is suspended only for Thanksgiving and Christmas if the holiday falls on a Monday or Thursday. *If your trash or* recycling pick up is missed, please contact CWD at 972-392-9300, Option 2.

Bulk, Brush, & Household Hazardous Waste Collection (Single-family Residents Only)

Who: Addison staff conducts home pickup for qualifying bulk items and brush less than 6 feet long. Please allow a minimum of 48 business hours (Monday - Thursday, 6am - 4:30pm) for staff to collect. Emergencies and special job operations may delay field crew response time.

Please visit www.AddisonTX.gov/bulktrash to request a pickup.

What:

Items that qualify for pickup include:

- Hot water heaters Mattresses
- Appliances without refrigerants

- Furniture
- Bags of leaves
- •Brush (less than 6 feet long)
- Cardboard boxes

Paint*

- Batteries*
- Light bulbs*

Items that **DO NOT** qualify for pickup include:

- Appliances containing refrigerants (refrigerators, freezers, AC units, etc.)
- Concrete/Asphalt
- Tires
- •Brush that is longer than 6 feet
- Propane tanks

- Tile flooring
- Soil
- Bricks/Landscaping rock

If your items are not on either list, please call 972-450-2871 to confirm whether or not they are eligible for pickup before submitting a request. Questions? Call 972-450-2871.



^{*}These items are considered hazardous waste. Please be sure to secure these items in a container, such as a cardboard box, and label them as hazardous waste before setting them out for pickup.
