## **Council Updates**

City Council Plans Special Meeting for White Rock Chapel on Monday,
December 4

The following Public Hearing will take place at a Special City Council Meeting on Monday, December 4 at the Addison Conference Centre. The Public Hearing will begin at 7:30pm. The agenda will be posted on the Town's website three days before the meeting.

Case 1901-SUP/5555 Celestial Road (White Rock Chapel). Hold a public hearing, present, discuss, and consider action on a request for a Special Use Permit (SUP) to allow a Religious Institution on 1.28± acres located at the northwest corner of Celestial Road and Winnwood Road (5555 Celestial Road), that is currently zoned Planned Development (PD), through Ordinance No. O91-038.

Unified Development Code (UDC) Sections Available for Review through the End of December



Addison is currently reviewing and updating its development regulations to clarify them and ensure they align with the Town's long-term goals and vision.
