Council Updates

Town Meetings Moved Back to the Conference Centre



More than 100 residents attended the April 3 Town Meeting at the Addison Conference Centre. Town meetings have been held in a local hotel since the pandemic and have now returned to their previous location. Council members provided updates on the Midway Road Revitalization Project, the Addison Airport, new businesses and restaurants, special events, area non-profits that provide services for residents, the Comprehensive Plan, and the Town's 70th anniversary. If you were unable to attend, you can watch the meeting on the Town's website.

The following Public Hearings will take place at the City Council meeting on Tuesday, April 11 at the Addison TreeHouse. The meeting begins at 7:30pm but work sessions are frequently held before the regular session. The agenda is posted on the Town's website three days prior to the meeting.

Midway Road Revitalization Update



Main lane construction along Midway Road is currently taking place at the north and south ends of the project limits. South of Belt Line Road, all traffic is anticipated to switch to the new southbound lanes later this month so work can begin on the northbound lanes between Proton Drive and Belt Line. Most of the utility work from Keller Springs Road to Dooley Road has been completed so crews have begun demolition and reconstruction of the main lanes in that area as well. Vitruvian Pond Pump Repairs To Take 2-3 Months



If you've visited Vitruvian Park lately, you may have noticed that the waterfall is not running. Unfortunately, the recirculation pumps in Vitruvian pond that pump the water for the fountains have failed and need to be replaced. The Town's installation contractor has indicated that because the lead time for receiving the pumps is approximately eight to ten weeks, repairs will take roughly two to three months.

In addition to powering the waterfall, the pumps recirculate water throughout the pond to aerate it and keep the water from becoming stagnant. Stagnant water can increase algae growth which creates ideal breeding conditions for mosquitoes. A lack of aeration can lead to an increase in ammonia levels which can potentially harm the natural wildlife in and around the water.

Thank you for your patience as we work to make these important repairs.

Free Mosquito Dunks and Repellant Available at Athletic Club and Town Hall Beginning April 10



To help Addison residents reduce the number of mosquitoes, and to protect themselves from mosquitos, the Town of Addison Environmental Health Division is giving away free Mosquito Dunks and Mosquito Repellant to Addison residents. Both products will be available while supply lasts at the Addison Athletic Center and at Addison Town Hall beginning Monday, April 10. There is a limit of two packages of dunks and one repellant per household.

Mosquito Dunks® are small, donut-shaped objects that float on the surface of the water and release bacteria that kill mosquito larvae in the water before they become adults. A single dunk will treat an area of about 100 square feet. It is important to know the approximate dimensions of your area to ensure that you get the proper number of dunks for effective treatment.

Mosquito Repellant helps avoid mosquito bites while outdoors. Always follow the label

instructions when using either of these products.


