White Rock Chapel Special Use Permit Request Denied

At its July 25 meeting, the City Council voted to deny a Special Use Permit request for White Rock Chapel located at 5555 Celestial Road. When owners of more than 20 percent of the land within 200 feet of a proposed zoning change file a written protest with the Town, as was the case with the White Rock Chapel request, the request must be approved by a three-fourths vote of the Council, which is six out of seven members. The Council was not able to reach the supermajority approval needed for the proposed zoning request to pass in its current form. However, the Council did vote to waive the one-year waiting period for refiling which allows the applicant the opportunity to bring forward a new request at any time.

Addison Airport Receives AIP Grant for Airport Master Plan

The City Council authorized acceptance of an Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant offer from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Aviation Division in the total amount of \$1,050,000 at its July 25 meeting. The funds, which include an airport sponsor matching share of 10% (equal to \$105,000), will be used to conduct an Airport Master Plan (AMP) update for Addison Airport.

An AMP is used to guide the development of an airport, including planning for grantfunded infrastructure improvements. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires airports that receive federal funding to maintain a current AMP. Addison Airport's <u>most</u> <u>recent AMP update</u> was approved in July 2016. The airport has experienced rapid redevelopment since 2016, which surpassed the pace of development denoted in the 2016 AMP, necessitating an AMP update.

The project will begin with consultant selection. Selection will be made by a committee composed of Town of Addison staff with the guidance of TxDOT Aviation. The AMP update is generally expected to take 18 to 24 months to complete.

Council Appoints Members to Parkland Dedication and Development Fee Study Advisory Committee

At its July 25 meeting, the City Council appointed the following residents to serve on a Parkland Dedication and Development Fees Study Advisory Committee. The Town recently engaged 110% Inc. to analyze the incorporation of parkland dedication, fee in lieu of land dedication, and park development impact fees to address redevelopment and growth in Addison. The consultant is also tasked with developing an ordinance to define the application and use of parkland dedication and fees associated with park development. The role of this resident advisory committee will be to represent the community's needs and help guide the process.

Rating Agencies Confirm Addison's Top Ratings

Moody's Investors Services and S&P Global announced this week that they have reaffirmed Addison's AAA credit ratings. Per Moody's release, the rationale for the rating includes that the Town's ample reserves are supported by an adept management team that uses conservative practices to guide budget planning and execution. S&P stated that consistent operating surpluses, aided by strong management and prudent spending, have enabled Addison to transfer excess general fund revenues into its capital project fund in each of the last three fiscal years while maintaining its healthy reserve levels.

Addison is one of only 11 cities in Texas with an Aaa rating from Moody's and an AAA rating from S&P.

- Adult incontinence supplies (Depends)


